Dear Grant Applicant:

Once again, the Elmwood Park Athletic Hall of Fame is proud to announce that it is accepting applications for monetary grants to be awarded and presented at our annual dinner on October 23, 2013.

Any and all Elmwood Park school teams, recreation department teams, independent athletic teams and independent athletic leagues are eligible for a Hall of Fame grant.

The project or proposal for which you may request funding can include any work to be performed, products to be purchased, money for camps, league entrance fees, clinics and/or any combination thereof or anything else which enhances, improves, or is deemed necessary for the athletic or sports program.

To be eligible for a grant, the official Grant Program Application must be completed in its entirety. First, you must provide your organization's background information, which includes years of existence, purpose, participants (number and age), season, facilities used, as well as any other pertinent data. Second, you must fully complete the bottom part of the Application, entitled "Proposal for Grant Funding". This includes completion of all five subsections, namely, 1) a detailed description of the project or proposal; 2) the value of the project or proposal to your organization; 3) the time element/deadline for the project or proposal; 4) the necessity for funding from the Elmwood Park Athletic Hall of Fame; and 5) the specific cost with verification for the project or proposal. If you do not fully complete the Application and all subsections, it may be rejected by the Board at the Board's discretion.
